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I Thomas Eames of lawful age testify
say that Charles Hall, being then in my
employ, was, on the fourteenth day of February
afore said, arrested by an armed man in a
military dress who was called by the name
of Sergeant Bunker, who informed me he
should carry Hall to the Fort at Stewart-
town, where I conclude Hall is now in
confinement.

I demanded of Bunker his authority,
he said he had no precept, that his
orders were verbal from the captain, to
take him alive or dead.
